Seeds:

- Start shopping now for flower and vegetable seeds. Look for starter trays, heating mats, [Earthbox planter](#), and Baccto light potting soils.
- Soon, it will be time to plant cool weather vegetable seeds and cool weather herbs, like chives and parsley .

Lawn:

- Shop now for your spring lawn supplies. You do not want to be waiting in line at the stores when you could be applying the [Turf Trust](#) and other supplies. If you are not sure what supplies you need, you can always call an expert at 1-800-721-6003.
- If you did not service your lawn mower, have it serviced now so that it is ready for spring.
- Check your spreader now to make sure it is in proper working order. Oil any parts that need oiled. When in need of a new spreader, we recommend the [Earthway 2100p](#).
- Even if you have a lawn service, you can purchase [Turf Trust](#) or other products that you want used on your lawn and have your lawn service company apply it. **Do not let them apply anything they want - they may use a short chained urea, which can cause root damage and surge growth, and may even cause leaf spot disease.**

House Plants:

- Jade plants that are dropping leaves are overwatered. Keep Jade plants in a location that will expose it to as much sun light as possible and keep the soil on the dry side. To help a Jade plant grow better, mix 1/2 a Tbsp of [SeaMate](#) with 1 Tbsp of hydrogen peroxide per quart of water. Use this mixture every time you water the Jade plant.
- White cottony sticky residue on a Jade plant indicates that the plant has mealy bugs. To treat this, use [Bonide Systemic House Plant Insect Control](#).
