## Lawn:

- Apply <u>Gallery weed prventer</u> on sunny lawns that usually become weedy during the summer. Note that this product is a broadleaf weed preventer that can be applied to shrub beds, flower beds, and lawns. It should be applied in early spring to prevent summer broadleaf weeds This is a weed preventer not a weed killer so weeds that have already germinated will not be killed.
- <u>PBI Gordons Speedzone</u> and <u>Bonide Weed Beater Ultra</u> are liquid lawn weed killers. They will kill lawn weeds as they grow and wild onions. The optimum time to use these products to kill weeds is when the average temperature is between 60-85°F, the lawn weeds are actively growing, and in the evening for the best absorption of the active ingredients.
- We recommend the use of an <u>Ortho Dial Sprayer</u> when applying <u>PBI Gordons</u> <u>Speedzone</u> or <u>Bonide Weedbeater Ultra.</u>
- Speedzone and Bonide Weedbeater ultra can also be used on zoysia lawns to kill wild onions.
- Never use lawn weed killers in vegetable gardens, shrub beds, or flower beds.
- Do not use *Weed and Feed* or granular lawn weed killers because they do not stick to lawn weed leaves as well as liquid weed killers.
- Always follow label instructions.
- The real *Rhizomes Tall Fescue* <u>Water Saver Seed</u> is sold only by Barenbrug, USA. When you shop for regenerating tall fescue be sure that the bag has the name Barenbrug on the bag. If the name, Barenburg, is not present on the bag, then you are not buying regenerating tall fescue that can multiple quickly and fill in bald spots. Names like waterwise, watersaver, and longroots are not the same product nor have the same ability as *Water Saver RTF by Barenburg*. Make sure that you bring home the right product, which is *RTF Tall Fescue Water Saver* with the name Barenburg on the bag.
- Common tall fescue clump and do not make rhizomes.
- Feed your Water Saver RTF Tall Fescue with <u>Turf Trust</u>. Never use short chained urea or combination fertilizers.

## Flower Beds:

- •To prevent summer weeds, apply *Greenlight Amaze or <u>Organic Greenlt</u>* in shrub and perennial beds before mulching, with SweetPee. If using <u>Greenit corn gluten</u> spray repeat application in six weeks.
- During the spring, use controlled released fertilizer on annual plants planted in flower beds (petunia, begonias, and inpatients) instead of using liquid fertilizers. Liquid fertilizers have a low efficiency rate, last only a few weeks, and can leach. Use controlled released fertilizer likeGarden Trust. Do not place the *Garden Trust* in the holes with the plant when planting, only side dress one week after planting, and only apply once a season.
- Garden Trust not only gives your flowers, nitrogen, phosphate, and potassium, but also gives them minor and trace elements in the ratio needed by the plants.

- Feed daffodils, lilies, and minor bulbs now if those bulbs had not been fed last fall. Use <u>Garden Trust</u>.
- When buying forced perennials, like prime roses or helleboris, keep the plants protected from frost. Plant these tender young perennials in early to mid-April in the ground, depending on weather. These plants will be hardy next winter when planted correctly.
